RE: EPA Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA).

The US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Code of Federal regulation 40 CFR Part 751, Regulation of Certain Chemical Substances and Mixtures under Section 6 of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) effective on February 5th, 2021 which regulates the manufacture (including import), processing, distribution in commerce, use, or disposal and recordkeeping of five Persistent Bioaccumulative and Toxic (PBT) chemical substances and mixtures that may be contained in products or articles in the USA. These chemicals are:

- 751.405: Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE, CAS 1163-19-5) a flame retardant with applications in wire and cable rubber casings, textiles, electronic equipment casings, building and construction materials, and imported articles such as aerospace and automotive parts.
- 751.407: Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP 3:1, CAS 68937-41-7) a flame retardant in plastics and as a functional fluid in aircraft and industrial machinery.
- 751.409: 2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP, CAS 732-26-3) an antioxidant in fuel additives and fuel injector cleaners as well as an additive in oil and lubricants.
- 751.411Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP, CAS 133-49-3) a substance with applications in the rubber industry.
- 751.413: Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD, CAS 87-68-3) a solvent in rubber manufacturing and in hydraulic, heat transfer or transformer fluid.
